

2010 AMBA Scholarship Award -- Requirements and Eligibility

Scholarship Purpose:

In recognition of the increasing value of higher education, and a commitment on the part of (*member company name*): _____ to facilitate higher education, this scholarship is intended to assist students who have the desire and ability to further their formal education.

Scholarship Awards:

Dependents of employees who are employed at (*member company name*) _____ will be eligible for the award. There will be one (1) \$1,000 scholarship for each AMBA Chapter and one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to encompass all non-chapter members. The scholarship will be awarded to an eligible high school senior or graduate for the purpose on continuing his/her education at an accredited educational facility.

Selection:

The Scholarship Selection Committee shall make the final selection of the scholarship recipient from a list of those students making an application under conditions outlined in the following paragraphs of eligibility and application. The Selection Scholarship Committee will consist of individuals selected by your local AMBA Chapter Board of Directors.

Eligibility:

The academic excellence and character of each applicant for the scholarship shall be the controlling factors to be considered by the Committee in awarding the scholarship. However, eligibility will be determined based on the following **three (3) requirements**:

1. Applicant is a member of a high school senior class and is planning to attend an accredited educational facility as a full-time student, or applicant is a high school graduate enrolled to continue his/her education at an accredited educational facility as a full-time student. For the purpose of this scholarship, full-time student is defined as a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester.
2. Applicant is a dependent of a currently employed person at (*member company name*) _____ of not less than one (1) year active employment. **Owners and/or major stockholders and/or their spouses/dependents are not eligible to receive this scholarship.**
3. Applicant must have a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average (based on a 4-point system). Information obtained regarding the applicant's grades, listing of classes, classroom participation, conduct, etc., is within standards set by the Scholarship Selection Committee.

Application Submission and Deadline:

Applicants are requested to read carefully all of the above conditions of this program and submit the following no later than **April 23, 2010**.

1. AMBA Scholarship Award application must be completely filled out.
2. Official high school scholastic records/transcripts to date and any college/university transcripts or equivalent.
3. Three (3) letters of reference from high school teachers, college professors or equivalent.
4. An essay relating to the students goals, objectives and need for the scholarship. The essay should not exceed 1,000 words or two (2) typewritten pages.
5. Please be sure to provide an email address on the application. A confirmation will be sent to applicant upon receipt of scholarship material via e-mail. All winners will be notified by June 2010.
